THE SUNDAY OF THE PASSION, PALM SUNDAY, MARCH 28

- 7:30 am** Palm Blessing & Eucharist
9:00* & 11:00 am* Eucharist, Blessing of the Palms, Processional & Passion Narrative. Services begin in the Nativity Hall.

1:00 pm Santa Eucaristía (Eucharist in Spanish)

MONDAY - WEDNESDAY, MARCH 29-31

- 6:00 pm** Evening Prayer – in the Chapel

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 31

- 10:30 am** Holy Eucharist – in the Chapel

MAUNDY THURSDAY, APRIL 1

- 6:00 pm*** Agapé Supper (Parish and Nativity Halls) followed by the Liturgy of the Last Supper (Church). For those unable to attend the supper, we will move to the church at approximately 7:00 pm. All are invited to participate in the meal as well as the foot washing, symbolic of the servant ministry Jesus instituted with the disciples. Music led by the women of St. Michael's Singers.
8:30 to 10:00 pm Prayer Vigil/Meditation in the Church

GOOD FRIDAY, APRIL 2

- 7:00 am** The Church reopens with Morning Prayer and remains open for prayer and meditation through the 7:00 pm service.
9:00 am to 7:00 pm Labyrinth available for prayer/meditation
9:00 am to 6:00 pm Reading the New Testament in the Chapel
12:00 noon Stations of the Cross in the Church: The traditional Stations said before each of the fourteen images of Christ's passion.
7:00 pm* Good Friday Liturgy (Bilingual). Principal service of the day with sermon and music lead by the men of St. Michael's Singers.

HOLY SATURDAY, APRIL 3

- 9:00 am** A brief service commemorates Jesus' body resting in the tomb.
9:00 am to 6:00 pm Reading the New Testament in the Chapel
12 Noon to 1:00 pm Sacrament of Reconciliation in the Chapel (other times by appt.)

THE GREAT VIGIL OF EASTER, SATURDAY NIGHT

- 8:00 pm*** The service begins in the Church in darkness.
As darkness comes, we light the Paschal Candle and re-tell ancient stories of God's love and call to us. We celebrate baptism and renew our own promises in the water of life. With the announcement that the Lord is risen and the sound of the trumpet, we celebrate the first Eucharist of Easter. A big party follows with music.
Incense is used at this liturgy.
