SATURDAY, APRIL 4

- 10:00 & 11:30 am** The Faces of Easter: A story for all ages

GOOD FRIDAY, APRIL 10

- 6:00 am** The Church re-opens and remains open for prayer and meditation through the 7:00 pm service.
9:00 am to 7:00 pm Labyrinth available for prayer/meditation
12:00 noon Stations of the Cross in the Church: The traditional Stations said before each of the fourteen images of Christ's passion. Ecumenical Walk of the Cross begins at noon at Bethlehem Lutheran Church, 1244 NE 39 Ave. and ends at St. Michael's with a service around 2:00 pm. Theme: *Toward a Human Economy – with God's Spirit, we can transform our broken system.*
7:00 pm* Good Friday Liturgy (Bilingual). Principal service of the day with music, choir and sermon.

HOLY SATURDAY, APRIL 11

- 9:00 am** A brief service commemorates Jesus' body resting in the tomb.
12 Noon to 1:00 pm Sacrament of Reconciliation in the Chapel (other times by appointment)

THE GREAT VIGIL OF EASTER, SATURDAY NIGHT

- 8:00 pm*** The Service begins in the Church in Darkness.
As darkness comes, we light the Paschal Candle and re-tell ancient stories of God's love and call to us. We celebrate baptism, and renew our own promises in the water of life. With the announcement that the Lord is risen and the sound of the trumpet, we celebrate the first Eucharist of Easter. A big party follows with music.
Incense is used at this liturgy.
