Ministry Description:

The Joyful Noise Arts Center was created to “*nurture the creative and spiritual growth of children through the arts.*” The Joyful Noise Arts Center is an after school program designed to facilitate children’s exposure to the arts, giving them the opportunity to recognize and develop their own creative potential. The Joyful Noise Arts Center is about engaging the spirit through our hands and feet, our hearts and minds, our sounds and our silences.

Local artist and St. Michael’s parishioner Julie Jetton helps children explore a variety of media throughout the course of the school year, including painting, ceramics, textiles and collage. Students’ artwork can often be found on display in St. Michael’s Parish Hall.

Three ten week terms are offered on Wednesday afternoons from 3:30 - 5:00 p.m. Tuition is \$40 per term with family rates and scholarships available.
